FUN, ENGAGING, MATH FACTS REVIEW GAME

PROVIDE YOUR STUDENTS WITH THE OPPORTUNITY TO SHOW THEIR Back BURNY WITH THEIR MULTIPLICATION AND DIVISION FACTS.

MATH FACTS CABOOM TEACHER DIRECTIONS:

- 1. First student pulls out a kaboom card from the face down pile.
- 2. The student and their partner(s) identifies the "answer" or "correct response." If their answer is correct they get to keep the card. If they answer it incorrectly, the card must go back in the pile.
- 3. The students continue around the circle, selecting one card at a time and everyone answering the same question (even if it's not their "turn," remember there are no TURNS!)
- 4. Any student who pulls a KABOOM! Card has to place all of their card(s) they have accumulated back into the pile or cup, leaving them with zero. (It may sound harsh, but it happens OFTEN, so all students will at some point get "Kaboomed!"
- 5. The game NEVER ENDS because eventually someone will get a Kaboom! and their cards will go back into the pile to keep the game going.
- 6. Optional: You can put a time limit on the game the winner will be the one who has the most cards at the end of the time limit.

MATH FACTS CABOOM

STUDENT DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Get with a partner or a group of 4. Place the cards face down in a pile.
- 2. Draw a card from the pile and EVERYONE answers the question on their recording sheet.
- If you get the answer correct, keep the card, but if you get it wrong it goes back into the pile.
- If you pull a KABOOM! card out to of the pile, you have to put all of your cards back in the pile face down.
- 5. Continue playing until time is up. The winner is the one with the most cards at the end of the game.
